

NOTICE OF PUBLIC FORUM

ON LOCATION AND DESIGN OF WELDON SPRING PARKWAY CONSTRUCTION PHASE 2

Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that an Open House Public Forum will be held at Weldon Spring City Hall, 5401 Independence Road, Weldon Spring Missouri, October 22, 2013, from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m., Central Daylight Time. Handicap access is available. All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning their views of the location and design of Weldon Spring Parkway Phase 2 with reference to the economic and social effects of such location and design, its impact on the environment and its consistency with the goals and objectives of the community. The presently contemplated improvement is as follows:

The Weldon Spring Parkway Phase 2 will continue from Phase One terminus on Weldon Spring Parkway and head east to Independence Road. The project will be constructing approximately 900 lineal feet of new concrete pavement. The new roadway will be constructed with three 11 feet wide lanes; 4 feet wide shoulders and 2.5 feet wide curb and gutter with storm sewers. A 10 foot wide asphalt trail will be constructed on the south side of the roadway. In addition to the Weldon Spring Parkway improvements, traffic signal modifications will be made at the intersection of O'Fallon Road and Missouri State Highway 94, as well as turn lane modifications at the intersection of Independence Road and Missouri State Highway 94, eliminating a left turn lane onto Highway 94 South.

Maps, plats, environmental documentation, and other detail information prepared by the City of Weldon Spring, or other interested agencies, will be available for public inspection and copying at the office of the City of Weldon Spring. Written statements and exhibits, as well as oral statements, will be received at the hearing. Written statements and an exhibit will be made a part of the public forum transcript if received within ten days after the date of the hearing.

Tentative schedules for construction will be discussed at the hearing.
