

**CITY OF WELDON SPRING  
REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
AUGUST 12, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER:** The regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Weldon Spring was held on Tuesday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at approximately 7:30 P.M. The meeting was held at the Weldon Spring City Hall, which is located at 5401 Independence Road. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Donald Licklider.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**A – SIGN ORDINANCE REVIEW – (Discussion):**

The Code Enforcement Officer (**Joe Hartman**) gave a Power Point presentation which showed the various sign offenses within the City.

**Mr. Hartman** indicated that he has not acted on some of the violations because he needed some direction from the Board.

Much discussion followed with the consensus of the Board being that we check with other cities and see what their sign ordinances allow and/or disallow.

Mr. Hartman will work something up and present to the Board within the next month.

**Alderman Robb** asked if the City of Weldon Spring would have any liability when it comes to the new County Park that is located within the City limits.

**Mayor Licklider** said “no” but he was going to talk with County and see if we have some say-so as far as what’s going to be included in the park since the property is in Weldon Spring.

**Alderman Kaiser** said that he has received several emails from residents who are very much in favor of a pedestrian pathway or walkway that would connect the Camelot Subdivision to the City Park. He continued by saying that the current crossing was dangerous and created a blind spot for both pedestrians and drivers. Alderman Kaiser said that he wanted an endorsement of the residents of Camelot and the Homeowners Association in order to pursue an alternative crossing.

The **Mayor** indicated that when the next phase of the Independence Road construction starts we will have a trail and a flashing light which will create a safer crossing across Independence Road.

**Alderman Kaiser** suggested that perhaps a temporary solution could be put in place until the road construction starts.

**Mayor Licklider** said that he would have the City Engineer take a look at the situation and see if something could be done but encouraged Alderman Kaiser to get the trustees on board.

**Mayor Licklider** mentioned the annual Missouri Municipal League Conference that will be coming up in September and stated that it is being held in St. Charles this year. He suggested that all of the Aldermen attend and told them to get with either the **City Administrator** (Michael Padella) or the **City Clerk** (Moe Kwiatkowski) so that they can get the registration in order.

**WORK SESSION:**

No Work Session was scheduled.

**CLOSED SESSION:**

There was no Closed Session.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

*\*\*\* Alderman Kolb moved to adjourn the meeting and Alderman Hillmer seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
